This list is for reference only, there will likely be other items that you will need, or want to take, depending on your particular situation and your vehicle.

## Frequent Baja Failures Include:

Roof Rack Mounts - Off Road Lighting/Mounts - Battery Tray/Hold Down Shock Absorbers - Radiator/Hoses - Exhaust System - Tires - Jack Spare Tire Carrier - Fuel Tank - After Market Accessories

Have your vehicle serviced, even if it is not time for a scheduled service. This service should include the inspection or replacement of the following items:

Engine Oil & Filter - Fuel Filters (some vehicles have more than one)
Air Filter - Spark Plugs (& points, if applicable) - Gear Box, Transfer
Case & Differential Oils - Drive Shafts - Wheel Bearings & Hubs
Brakes (Hand Brake also) - Belts (Fan Belts, A/C Belt, etc.)
Air Conditioner - Hoses & Coolant - Lights & Battery - Tires (they should have at least 50% of the tread left)
Carefully Check the Installation of any After Market Accessories

## **Spare Parts List:**

(Many items can be bought locally, but that doesn't mean a thing in the middle of the desert.)

Fuel Filters - Belts - Fuses - Oil - Transmission Fluid - Keys - Coolant

## Other Items To Take:

Duct Tape - Wire - Bungee Cords - Rope - HD Cord - Tow Rope/Cable Tire Repair Kit (for tubeless tires, or a spare tube) - Slime - Good 12 volt Compressor - Good Jack (and something to stabilize it in soft sand) Miscellaneous Tools - Drinking Water - First Aid Kit - Good Baja Map Portable GPS Unit (optional)
